### Dressage

Schooling for dressage will be available Wednesday August 23rd after 5pm

Dressage Classes will all be run on August 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> (test times will be sent out by August 22nd)

- We will be running an AEF Wild Rose Sanctioned show so USEF tests will be used.
- Introductory to 3rd Level
- Show jackets are not required but encouraged. (Tank-tops, graphic t-shirts are not permitted)
- Ribbons will be presented from 1<sup>st</sup> place to 6<sup>th</sup> place.
- Grand Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be presented for each division.
- 3 test max per horse and rider combination
- Dressage test are \$40 per test.

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## Jumpers

Clear Rounds will be on Friday August 25<sup>th</sup> (times will be announced after entry closing date)

- One round per rider
- 3 refusals allowed.
- Coaches and parents can enter to help cross rail riders ONLY.
- Clear round ribbons will be handed out at the gate.

Jumpers will be on **Saturday and Sunday August 26th and 27th** (see schedule for order of classes. Start times will be decided closer to the show)

- Jumpers will be run as an AEF Wild Rose Sanctioned Show.
- Clear rounds are available Friday afternoon/evening (times to be booked the week of the show)
- Show Jackets are not required (Tank-tops, graphic t-shirts are not permitted)
- Ribbons will be presented from 1<sup>st</sup> place to 6<sup>th</sup> place.
- Grand Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be presented for each division.
- Only two consecutive divisions permitted per horse and rider combination.
- Jumper Divisions consist of 3 jump rounds and are \$75 per division.

## Jumper Classes

### **Clear rounds**

- Available on Friday only
- Intended to help riders and horses get around a course before the show starts.
- Ribbons awarded to riders with no faults or refusals.
- Clear Round classes are \$25 a class.

### **Cross rails 10 and under**

- This is intended for riders 10 and under
- All 3 rounds will be Optimum Time
- Optimum time will not be judged on speed!

### **Cross rails**

- This is intended for green riders or horses.
- All 3 rounds will be Optimum Time
- Optimum time will not be judged on speed!

### GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

1. The management reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any error or make any alterations that may be necessary in the prize list.
2. The management reserves the right to cancel or combine any class not filled to satisfaction; whereupon riders will be notified as soon as possible after close of entries.
3. Inhumane treatment of a horse will not be tolerated. Violation of this rule, at the discretion of the organization committee, will result in disqualification and forfeiture of fees, all winnings and loss of entry.

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4. Numbers must be always worn and visible in the schooling and/or exercise areas as well as in the competition ring.
5. Riders are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, handler, or rider, will disqualify the horse, and result in forfeiture of entry fees for subsequent classes. Management reserves the right to remove a groom, handler/ rider and/ or horse from the show, without being liable for compensation.
6. No judge shall be approached with regards to any decision during the time he is judging or is about to judge. Penalty will be disqualification from the show in its entirety.
7. The medical aid fee covers the cost of medical aid on site. The fee does not cover personal expenses incurred by the injured party in the event of an injury or transportation by ambulance.
8. No person other than officials, staff on duty, and the judges of the classes may enter the competition rings without permission. Competitors are allowed in the competition rings only when competing, when the course is open for walking or during scheduled schooling rounds.
9. Dogs must be always on a leash. For safety and sanitary reasons, no dogs will be permitted in the schooling area, show rings, or show office.

## ENTRIES

1. Entries will be only conditionally accepted until the rider has created their online sponsorship/fundraising page via link which will be provided in the conditional acceptance email and paid their entry fees.
2. Payment of fees is by e-transfer. Once entry has been conditionally accepted, an email notification with e-transfer details and fundraising site link will be emailed to the rider within 3 business days. As this is a fundraising horse show for CASA Mental Health, all riders are to create a fundraising page and are requested to fundraise. Once the fundraising page has been created and fees e-transferred, the conditional entry acceptance will be considered formally accepted. The Highest fundraiser will have all entry fees refunded plus will win prizes.

## REFUNDS

Riders cancelling their entries after the official closing date, but prior to the start of the show shall, upon presentation of a valid veterinary certificate, forfeit their stall, tack/feed stall and office fees, but will be refunded stall clean deposit, show number deposit and 50% of all other fees. After the closing date non-veterinarian scratches will not be refunded. Substitutions will be permitted, prior to the start of the show. If riders so choose, instead of having the fees refunded as per above, they may be donated to Emily's Memorial Horse Show and a tax receipt will be provided by CASA Mental Health.

## STABLING

1. Tack/feed stalls are available for \$50.00 for the duration of the show.
2. Shavings must be pre-ordered ordered on the entry form; there will be minimal extra bedding available at the show.
3. No horse will be placed in an unassigned stall without approval from management.
4. Stabling will be available from 3pm August 23rd and is available until August 27th.
5. A refund of \$50 will be given to competitors who clean out and have their stall checked. Dirty shavings are to be shovelled/swept into the alleyway for cleaning by the skid steer. Riders who depart the show before August 27<sup>th</sup> are to clean out their stall and place the dirty shavings and manure in the manure bin.
6. Stalls and shavings must be booked at time of registration on your entry form.

## RIBBONS

1. Ribbons will be given to sixth place.
2. Points for championships shall be awarded on the following basis: 1st (7 points), 2nd (5 points), 3rd (4 points), 4th (3 points), 5th (2 points), 6th (1 point).
3. Jumper & Dressage Championship: The Champion and Reserve Champion titles shall be awarded to the two horses that have accumulated the most points performing in the division in which they are being shown.
4. Clear round ribbons will be given at the gate

## CLEAR ROUNDS

1. Jumper clear rounds will be available the late afternoon of Friday, August 25<sup>th</sup>.

It is understood that under no circumstances shall Emily's Memorial Horse Show., nor the owners, management, tournament committee, nor any of its staff or agents be liable for any loss, damages, claims or costs as a result of Emily's Memorial Horse Show., nor the owners, management, tournament committee, nor any of its staff or agents, negligence, and that you agree to indemnify and save harmless Emily's Memorial Horse Show., nor the owners, management, tournament committee, nor any of its staff or agents from and against any and all liability arising out of such loss, damages, claims or costs.

## RV PARKING

1. Camping is permitted on ground for competitors only. Absolutely under no circumstances will fires be permitted. Anyone caught having a fire will be asked to immediately leave the show, no refunds will be given. Propane fires are permitted.
2. Dogs must be always on leashes and feces must be picked up.
3. Please clean up after yourself.

## BIOSECURITY

Bio Security is everyone's responsibility! The Emily's Memorial Horse Show is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for all riders and their horses. All show participants are requested to practice good disease prevention practices. Travelling and showing horses are at an increased risk for spreading and contracting contagious diseases. All horses entering the show grounds must not have been in contact with any sick horses within the last 14 days. They must not exhibit any sign of illness. All horses coming on to the grounds must provide proof of valid Equine Influenza and EHV vaccinations (vaccinations must be administered within the last 6 months, but not within 7 days of arrival to the grounds). Horses exhibiting any signs of illness are not permitted on the grounds. Competitors are required to notify the office at the first sign of illness. Horses missing valid vaccinations will NOT be permitted on the grounds and entries are NOT eligible for a refund of fees. NO EXCEPTIONS. Proof of vaccination must be supplied. The name on the vaccination MUST MATCH the name on the entry to be acceptable. Horses are not permitted to come on to the grounds if they are stabled at a facility where any horses have been at a venue with a confirmed case of EHV (neurologic or non-neurologic) or any other transmissible disease/ illness within the last 10 days. Please avoid direct and/or indirect contact between horses, especially nose-to-nose contact
