


## OUR STORY

In 2013, there were 535 suicides in Alberta. Our 17 year old daughter, Emily, was one of those hopeless souls and on November 18, 2013 we were forced onto this lifelong journey of learning to live without her. In Emily's memory, and as a part of our recovery from this heartbreaking loss, we have become advocates for changes to the mental health system. We want to reduce the stigma surrounding mental illness and suicide, as well as advocate for funding for treatment facilities. Talking about mental health and suicide prevention is essential and we are taking it one step further.



Every day, adolescents who are at risk of suicide are discharged from emergency rooms with nowhere to go. We walked out of emergency rooms on so many occasions with nowhere safe to take Emily. Seven hours after her last emergency room visit, Emily took her life.



CASA House is the only in-patient adolescent mental health treatment facility of its kind in Alberta and there can be up to a one year waiting list for admission. That is far too long! More in-patient treatment beds and facilities are so direly needed

to treat these kids who are brave enough to ask for help, and whose parents live every day in fear of losing their child because they are unable to get the treatment they desperately need.
